Minutes of a Meeting of Little Chalfont Parish Council Planning Committee Held in the Village Hall on Wednesday 8 June 2011 at 7.30pm

- 1. Apologies for absence: These were received from Cllr J Hinkly.
- 2. **Approval of the minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on Tuesday 17 May 2011**: These were approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.
- 3. Proposal to suspend standing orders enabling members of the public to speak (10 mins): The proposal was agreed and Cllr Hunt suspended standing orders. Mr Knight, Mr Pate and Mr Arnold spoke in opposition of the proposal by Vodaphone to install a mast and equipment on the Cokes Lane verge outside number 2, Linfields. Since the last Planning Committee meeting a number of residents had met with a representative of the company but they did not feel they had received satisfactory responses, particularly in respect of other suggested sites, proof of demand, technical justification and other models of mast. They remained firmly against the proposals. Thanking members of the public for their contribution Cllr Hunt reinstated standing orders

- 10. **Railway Communications Systems mast Chalfont and Latimer station:** Summarising a letter dated 23 May from Network Rail, the Clerk advised that the company were hoping to install a railway communication mast adjacent to the station on Transport for London land. A drop-in session, attended by the project team, will be held at the Methodist church on 27 June and it was agreed that Cllr Rafferty should attend and report back to the Planning Committee on 28 June.
- 11. Waste Transfer Station update: Application has still not been submitted.
- 12. Pre-con 19373 Proposed Vodaphone/03 base station at Cokes Lane / Linfields: Cllr Drew reported back on a meeting that had been held with Mr H Cave (representing the applicants) on 24 May. Cllr Martin (CDC), Cllr Hunt and the Clerk had also attended. The site had been visited as had others suggested by the Parish Council. However, Mr Cave was of the opinion that the only suitable site was that proposed outside no 2 Linfields. His view was that other locations would not provide an adequate signal to the "coverage hole" that Vodaphone was trying to fill. The Parish Council representatives were surprised to hear that the proposed increase in the capacity of the Pollards Wood mast (see CH/2011/0681/FA above) would not help reception in the area and were of the view that such a huge, intrusive installation at Cokes Lane/Linfields was an excessive solution to an alleged problem affecting very few people. In conclusion, Cllr Drew commented that discussions still had a long way to go, that a formal planning application was awaited and there would no doubt be further discussion at the next Planning Committee meeting scheduled for 28 June 2011.
